

The Farmersville Town Board meeting held on March 21, 2016 was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Jerry Chmiel. All stood for the pledge.

A motion was made by Mr. Roblee to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Mr. Spencer carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Spencer to accept the financial report seconded by Mr. Roblee ,carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Isaman to accept the town clerk's report seconded by Mr. Roblee, carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Roblee to accept the code enforcement report seconded by Mr. Westfall, carried.

A motion was made to by Mr. Spencer to go into executive session for possible ligation at 7:05 pm seconded by Mr. Westfall,carried

A motion was made to come out of executive session at 7:29pm by Mr. Roblee and seconded by Mr. Westfall, carried.

Hwy report:

Mr. Tingue reported that the screen grizzly was done, they were working on paver and had just ordered some steel for it. The broom & tractor were both fixed and up & running.

He asked the board if he could look into a roller and the board said to get some prices. He gave a report on the repair work done to the 550 truck since 5/14/12 and total price was \$25,208.79. It was down again and the part alone was \$300.-\$500.00, said that the town might consider getting a new one- said he could get some prices on that. Also he suggested that a 1 ton might not be the way to go would also like to look into ton& half or a 2 ton truck. Mr. Isaman asked if the excavator was big enough to do the jobs and maybe we should look into trading while the value was up. Mr. Tingue stated that he was also thinking along those lines. The board asked him to come up with a realistic wish list for long range plans. Mr. Tingue also said he was getting ready to start ditching Hess, Stebbins and County Line. Asked about progress on signs for Reynolds Rd and he said he had put one on Brown Rd and was waiting for the rules for the high visibility signs that are now required. Clerk Holmes stated that Mr. Tingue and

herself were working on grants for the hwy dept. Mr. Spencer asked if the hwy dept would check out the sluice pipe that was by his house, stated there was a hole in the road and seems to be getting bigger, Mr. Tingue stated that he would.

Old Business:

Mr. Chmiel stated that he would like to have a work session to work on the changes that the board would like for the dog law on April 6,2016 at 7:00pm.

On the matter of the peddling law- Clerk Holmes stated she had included a copy of the law from the Town of Hume for everyone. The Board decided to table the matter until further notice.

Mr. Tingue asked about his buyout for his insurance, that he had done some research and it would cost the town \$8025.92 for his insurance for 1 year and he was asking for \$3000.00 which would be a savings of \$5025.92 to the town. Stated that the Town of Freedom did a buyout at 70% and also the Village of Franklinville did a buyout but did not know the exact amount. Mr. Chmiel asked if he had signed the paper that was given to him that he was not taking the insurance and he stated, no he had not. Board stated that there was no buyout for elected officials.

New business:

It was brought by town resident Mrs. Vickman that the SPCA had come to the county to request \$25,000.00 to take care of the animals on a farm in Farmersville. That brought on the discussion of the case that was ongoing in Farmersville by the town board and other town residents in attendance.

Mr. Westfall asked the reporter about news articles in the paper about town board meetings and she said that she had been off on maternity leave and that it usually took 2 weeks to get the article in. Mr. Chmiel stated that anyone could look at the website for the minutes of the monthly meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Isaman to pay the bills seconded by Mr. Spencer, carried

A motion was made by Mr. Roblee to table a bill for the appraisal meetings –he would like a breakdown of everything that was done by the Appraisal Consultants for the reval, seconded by Mr. Spencer, carried.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Mr. Roblee at 8:30pm seconded by Mr. Spencer, carried
