The town board worked on going over the draft law that was received from the Town of Freedom for the wind energy law. The board felt that the first few pages of the title, purpose, definitions and the permits required were to be kept and used for our law.

A comment was made by resident Ginger Schroeder that the time of 6:30pm for the meeting was not put in the notice for the work session and that the meeting was illegal. Town Clerk Holmes stated that was her mistake and she acknowledged that she had made a mistake. Attorney Strassel felt that there was no reason for the board not to proceed and Ms. Schroeder stated that it should be noted in the minutes.

Under Article II statement 10, Decommissioning Plan the question was asked about the money that would be available for the decommissioning. Attorney Strassel stated that was one of the concerns he has brought up before about the energy having a bond in place for this aspect. Something the board should look more into. On statement 12 (b) the town board would like a detailed list of the routes that the energy company would be using of town roads and it cannot vary.

The board had a discussion on having or incorporating a geological aspect into the law.

Section 12 – Traffic Routes the board wants to reference the Hwy Bond law in this law.

Section 13 – Discussion was made on section 13 (a) about the sound pressure level measured for the nearest property line and not the nearest residence as stated in this law. No decision made for this.

On Section 13 a point was brought up that on E. that the setback for a personal tower and a commercial do not match and the personal tower is more and that they should match.

The town board will continue to work on this law at a later date.
