There was a discussion on proceeding with the wind energy law and having a public hearing and Mr. Strassel informed the board that the law had to be sent to the County Planning Board before they could have a public hearing.

Town clerk Holmes presented information that she had collected from various towns across NYS with wind projects.

The topics still open from previous work session was the Decommissioning Plan and Mr. Zink stated that both he and Mr. Warner had talked to various people and they were satisfied with the Decommissioning part of this law, so the board agreed to leave it as is.

Discussion of the sound and the board agreed to put in Section 13 that the dBA is 50 with no plus or minus.

Also discussed was in Section 13 E-1. It is to be 1.5 x tip height, 2- 1.5 x tip height, 3- 1800ft from residence, 4- 1.5 x tip height, 5- 2200ft.

Also discussed that Section 12 should have it added – to see road use agreement with detail list of routes.

It also was decided by the board to hold a public hearing at the Farmersville Fire Department with a tentative date of August 13, 2018 at 6:30pm.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mrs. Tilton at 8:03pm and seconded by Mr. Westfall, carried.
