A motion was made by Mr. Zink to accept the minutes and seconded by Mr. Warner, carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Zink to accept the financial report and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried.

A motion was made to accept the clerk's report by Mr. Westfall and seconded by Mr. Warner, carried.

A motion was made to accept the dog report by Mr. Warner and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Warner to accept the code enforcement's report and seconded by Mr. Zink, carried. Along with his report Mr. Cummings wrote down some suggestions about the fees in his department and where there should be adjustments made.

Hwy Report:

The roller has been received and at the present time the hwy employees were hauling millings from Ellicottville with a project that New York State was working on, and the town hwy department will be working with the state this fall again with the millings. The other item that Mr. Tingue had was that Bear Creek Rd was going to be closed the week of the 21st from 7am to 4pm till Friday as the railroad company was working on the railroad crossing.

Judge Karcher presented a judges report.

Old Business:

Supervisor Karcher brought up that the carpet in the clerk's office needed to be replaced because of the condition of it and that he would be working on getting prices for the new one for the next board meeting.

NY Class – Clerk Holmes stated that she had emailed the resolution needed for the joining of this group to the lawyer and he okayed it but felt that NY Class should provide a letter of credit to the town and Clerk Holmes stated that she had not done anything else, a motion was made by Mr. Zink to get the paperwork together to be able to go forward with NYClass for next month and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried.

Wind Energy: Mr. Karcher stated at this time that the meeting was being recorded by the town clerk and also that Ginger Schroder was recording at the present time.

Supervisor Karcher stated that there were representatives from Invenergy present and that he felt that the informational meeting went well, at this time Clerk Holmes stated that she had received complaints from some of the residents that they went to the meeting to get information all they heard was the negatives from other town residents and people outside of town. Some questions were asked by the residents present at the meeting of the representative.

Solar Moratorium: Supervisor Karcher stated that the current moratorium would run out in September and that the town lawyer had drafted a new law up extending the moratorium. A motion was made by Mr. Zink to bring the new law on the solar moratorium to public hearing on June 18, 2018 at 7pm and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried.

New Business

There will be a work session on June 4th at 6:30pm at the town hall to work on the wind energy law.

Mr. Zink at this time suggested that there should be a separate page linked on our website for the wind project, all agreed that would be a good idea.

A motion was made by Mr. Westfall to pay the bills and seconded by Mr. Warner, carried.
